Ratings Watch List Process

A watch list form can be submitted to request the raising or lowering of a players rating. Managers or coaches can begin submitting a watch list at the start of the season to have a player rating lowered from there team. Four weeks into the season a manager or coach can submit a watch list for any player on any team within their division to have them raised.

- Locate the form on the SFGSL web site: www.sfgsl.org or ask your division rep.
- Complete and submit the form online. (this will include time and date stamp for our records) You should print a copy for your records.
- Send in the appropriate Watch List fee(s) to the SFGSL at 584 Castro St., PMB 835, San Francisco, CA 94114
 - There is an initial \$10 fee to submit a Watch List form, plus \$5 for each question identified on the watch list form. (example: a Watch List form with 3 questions indicated would require a \$25 fee)
 - If the submitted watch list results in a player's rating being changed for the identified question, the initial fee and the question fee will be returned to the individual who submitted the form.
- The Watch List Evaluation Committee Chair (WECC) will inform the manager of a player being placed on a watch list.
 - It is the MANAGERS responsibility to inform the player a watch list has been submitted on a player.
- Submitted Watch List forms will be distributed by the Watch List Evaluation Committee Chair to a Watch List Evaluation Team. (WET)
- The WET will have about 4 weeks of play to evaluate each player(s) and send the results to the Watch List Committee Chair.
- The WECC will notify the Division Rep and the Manager of the results.
 - It is the MANAGERS responsibility to inform the player of the results.
- Ratings Watch List forms can be submitted up until the 4th to last week of the season.
